Cayman Brac - commonly referred to simply as the Brac, is 12 miles long and over 1 mile wide with a distinguishing bluff running through its center. Brac is Gaelic for bluff. This bluff starts at sea level on the west end of the island, and rises to about 140 feet at the eastern tip of the island.

The island offers natural beauty, friendliness and some of the best diving anywhere in the world. Cayman Brac's greatest attraction is its surrounding waters. Marine life of all shapes and sizes abound in these clear, warm waters of the Caribbean.

Cayman Brac has some great wreck dives. In 1996 a 330 foot Russian warship with four deck guns, renamed the MV Capt. Keith Tibbetts, was sunk off the west end of the island. As well, there are three other wrecks in the area, the 65-foot Cayman Mariner, the 60-foot tugboat Kissimee and the Prince Frederick which ran aground in 1897. Other sites around Cayman Brac include an ancient anchor embedded in a wall, many shallow coral reefs and Turtles, Spotted Eagle Rays, Reef Sharks, Nassau Groupers, Moray Eels, Stingrays, Horse-Eye Jacks, Barracuda, Flying Gurnards and more! There are more than 100 different hard and soft corals and over 500 species of fish. There is unlimited visibility...usually 100 to 150 feet...with little or no current.

At the resort you can relax at the Day Spa, or work out at the Fitness center. Also on property is a boutique, & photo/video center. Car rentals and bikes for the guest use are available and there is a Market place grocery store 3 miles from the resort.

The rooms have individually controlled air conditioning, as well as an overhead ceiling fan, color cable television, radio/alarm clock, hair dryers, irons & ironing board, drying lines and coffee makers.
